This will be the last Governor's Bulletin until July when we will start our New Pilot year!

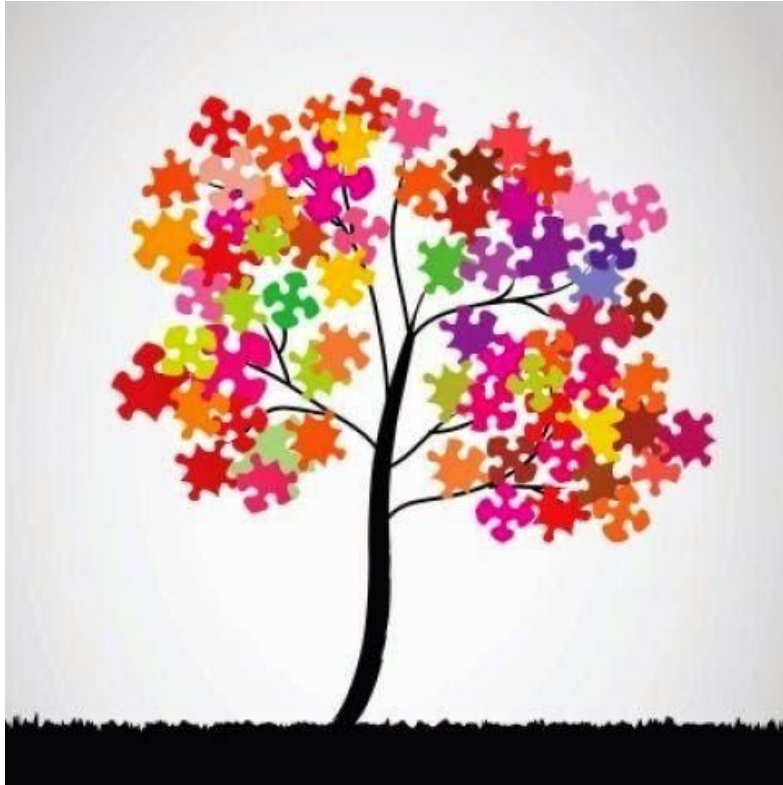
